Mid way through 2025, we must give congratulations to all the competitors and winners already this season! Not only in our own country but Canadian breeding programs and competitors certainly excelled across the venues at the ASSA National. It makes all Canadian Sheltie fanciers proud to see the dogs achieving the wins!

The new executive team has quickly begun working on a variety of matters:

- ROMC & Versatility Certificates process changes to include distribution on a quarterly basis.
- ROMC transition of files from Bob Miller and development of new database to capture the information.
- Expansion of Top Dog Awards to include Top Agility, Top Veteran, Top Herding and Top Altered. Top Dog awards will now be awarded annually rather than biennially when they were distributed at the National Specialty banquet.
- Code of Ethics – amendment to ensure content relevance and to adapt to changes in best practices over the last 15 years.
- Expansion of Regional Events to include a financial stipend supplied after the event has been held. Designed to encourage more Sheltie centric events across the country, the Board wanted to alleviate part of the financial burden these events incur by assisting with expenses and hopefully prompting more events across the country.
- Approving 2 Conformation Regionals which happens to include the first ever to be held in BC. You can see details on the Cranbrook, BC and Calgary, AB regionals elsewhere in this newsletter.

There are more matters being tackled including the CKC required By-Law review, an update to our National Specialty Guidelines and a conversion of forms to online, fillable versions. On that note, watch for more details on the 2026 National Specialty to be held Oct 8-11, 2026 in Chilliwack, BC. The National will be held in conjunction with the 4 day all-breed Fraser Valley Dog Fanciers show so get those dates in your calendar!

Enjoy the summer season with your dogs, and if you're competing, best of luck to us all!

MEMBER CODE OF ETHICS  
 Revision: March 17, 2025

Established in 1988, the CSSA is the National Shetland Sheepdog Parent club of the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) representing purebred Shetland Sheepdog activities, and to preserve and enhance the purebred Shetland Sheepdog. Incorporated under the Canada Not-For-Profit Corporation Act in 2008, the CSSA is a national membership organization.

The Code of Ethics (COE) are member guidelines for a high standard of ethical practices in the breeding, buying, selling and exhibiting of the Shetland Sheepdog. Members agree to adhere to the By-laws, rules and regulations established by the CSSA Board of Directors and the CKC where applicable. It further recognizes that membership in the Club automatically obligates individuals to this Code of Ethics.

1. Members shall promote honesty, integrity, sportsmanship and cooperation among breeders, owners, and exhibitors of Shetland Sheepdogs for the benefit of the breed.
2. Members shall strive to educate, or direct toward resources that can educate, any novice owner who wishes to become involved with breeding and/or showing of the breed.
3. Members shall not speak on behalf of the CSSA unless granted permission by its Executive.
4. Members shall provide adequate shelter, nutrition, socialization, veterinary care and exercise for their dogs ensuring they are maintained in a safe and sanitary environment.
5. Members shall not knowingly aid, abet, sell or supply any dogs or stud services/brood matrons to pet stores, wholesalers, raffles, lotteries, auctions, flea markets, consignments, laboratories (unless sanctioned by the CSSA) or as give-away prizes. Nor shall they place their own dogs using a Rescue Service.
6. Members accept full responsibility for their breeding practices and shall take back dogs where an owner can no longer care for the dog or shall assist in re-homing said dog. Further, a member breeder of a rescued Sheltie, will upon notification from a recognized rescue organization, attempt to retrieve the dog from rescue in order to provide for the dog's care.
7. Breeders shall be familiar with and agree to abide by all Canadian Kennel Club rules and regulations including registration of litters, individual dogs, transfers of ownership and maintenance of accurate records of breeding, pedigrees, and sales.
8. Breeders shall provide purchasers with details as to the health and care requirements of the dog. Permanent tattoo or microchip, and a record of vaccination shall accompany each dog when it leaves the premises. It is recommended puppies are placed after 8 weeks of age, having been health checked by a licensed veterinarian and receiving initial immunization.
9. The overall objective of a member's breeding program shall be to strive for breed improvement by breeding to the CKC Shetland Sheepdog Standard. Prior to breeding, all breeding stock should be screened for genetic disorders, such as but not limited to, current OFA CHIC breed specific guidelines.
10. Breeders shall consider the age, health and welfare of their dogs before breeding them and will proceed with caution to avoid harm.
11. Breeders shall strive to place any dog discharged from their care in a home that will adequately provide for the health and welfare of the dog and shall be discriminating in the placement of breeding stock.
12. It is recommended that all contracts, agreements, and guarantees be in writing and include all agreed upon terms. Members shall honour in full, all terms they give in said documents.
13. Advertising by members will be as factual as possible and shall not be false or misleading.
14. Failure to adhere to this Code of Ethics may result in termination of membership as per the By-laws of the corporation. Members that lose CKC privileges or are in contravention of federal or provincial animal welfare legislation, will automatically lose CSSA membership.

## **In Memoriam – Diane Biggar**

February 16, 1944 – April 3, 2025

### **Kendale Perm. Reg'd – Collies & Shetland Sheepdogs**

With deep sadness the CSSA marks the passing of Diane Biggar, the guiding force behind the celebrated Kendale Collies & Shelties. Diane passed peacefully at Brockville General Hospital, Ontario, leaving behind friends, family, and countless individuals whose lives she touched in the dog-show community.

A native of Prince Edward Island, Diane moved to rural Spencerville, Ontario, in the 1970's and registered Kendale. Over nearly five decades she bred Rough & Smooth Collies and, later, Shetland Sheepdogs renowned for sound structure, lovely head planes and eye, and easy, willing temperaments.

Early stand-outs include Am/Can CH. Kendale Wiseguy, a Smooth Collie, who was the top-ranked Smooth Collie in Canada in 1988. Additionally, Am/Can CH. Kendale Firepower ROM anchored the Collie pedigrees of many kennels to follow, and in 2005 her homebred Ch. Kendale Tornado "Tory" finished the year as Canada's #4 Rough Collie.

Diane's love of shelties soon took equal stage. Among her many stars was Kendale Opal Essence (Can CH. Laureate Inception ROMC x Kendale Dury Voe Shine On), who earned High in Trial obedience at the 2018 CSSA National Specialty with a sparkling 197/200 alongside owner Lynda Morrissey. Diane helped put more championships on dogs than one could count, always with humility and exemplary sportsmanship.

Beyond the record books, ringside friends will remember the ever-present "Kendale chair," Diane's encyclopedic pedigree recall, and her readiness to loan a grooming tool or steady a novice handler's nerves. Many current exhibitors can trace their first show prospect or their first words of encouragement to her. She will be missed and always remembered.

On a personal note, I first met Diane at the very beginning of my own journey in the breed, knowing nothing of her long list of accolades. She opened her home to me and my loud young sheltie without a hint of pretension, seeing only a fellow admirer of the breed. I doubt she ever imagined that the wide-eyed newcomer she welcomed that day would one day write her memoriam for the CSSA. Her kindness, humility, and quiet faith in people, and in shelties, remain her greatest legacy.
